On Thursday, April 18, 2024, a Filipino film evening will take place as part of the community:cinema at the Kulturfabrik Koblenz. In collaboration with the German-Filipino Aid Association Helping Hands e.V. and with the support of the Consulate General of the Philippines in Frankfurt am Main.

Enjoying culturally typical snacks and performances, you'll gain insight into Filipino culture. The program includes dance, singing, as well as the presentation of the latest work by Filipino author Joseph Lumen titled "Ausländer," and a delicious buffet featuring various Filipino specialties, including the popular dishes Adobo and Ube, Pancit, and Lumpia. Guests are warmly invited to bring their own interpretations of Adobo and Ube for a "Food Challenge."

The highlight of the evening is the film "Leonor will never die" directed by Martika Ramirez Escobar from the year 2022: Falling into a coma is typically associated with unpleasant events. Leonor Reyes, an aging icon of Filipino action cinema, experiences exactly this after a television falls on her head. However, this incident gives her the opportunity to finalize her life's work, a screenplay, and she learns through her son how important family truly is. The screening of the film in Filipino with English subtitles is generously supported by the University of the Philippines Alumni Association in Germany.
